

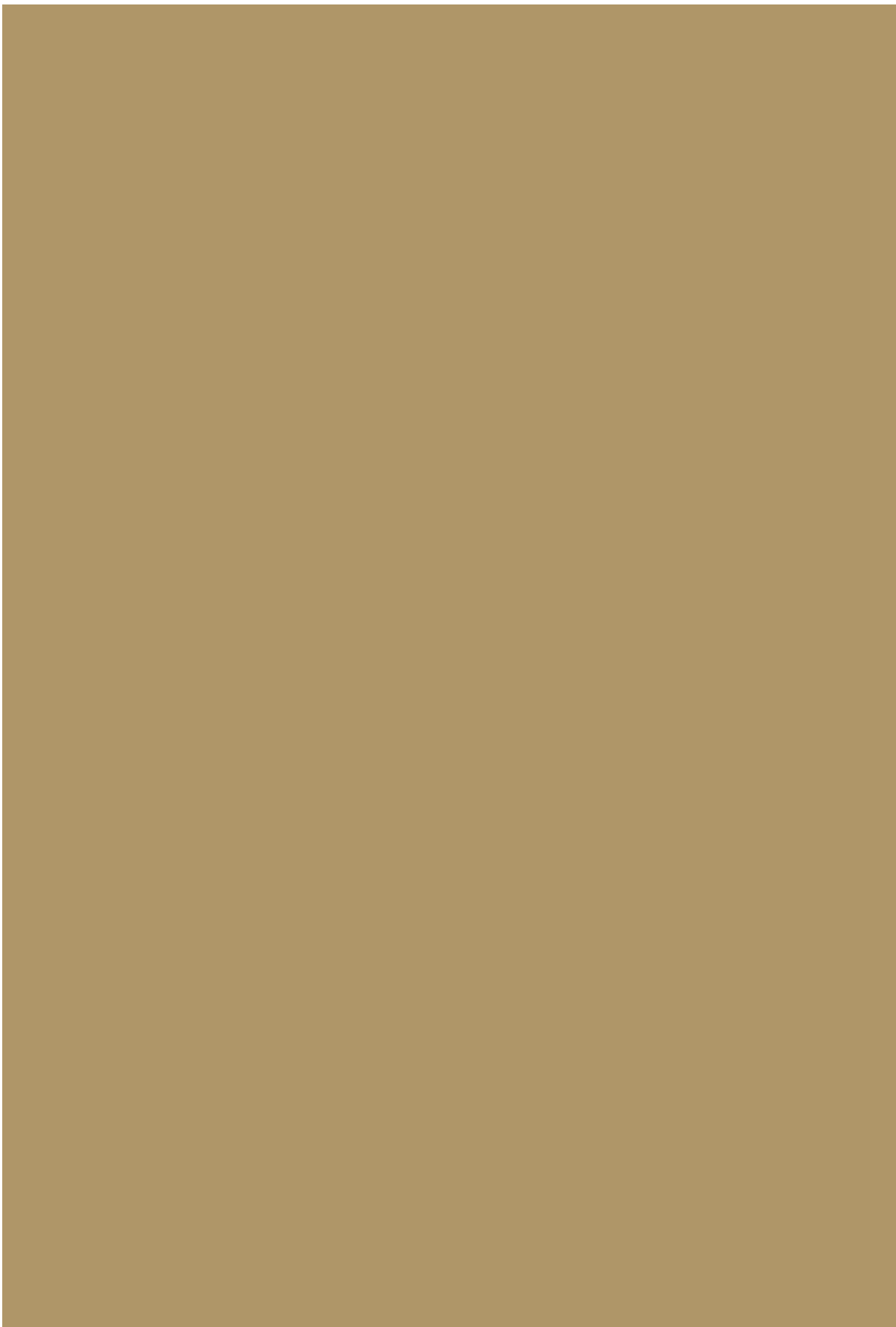

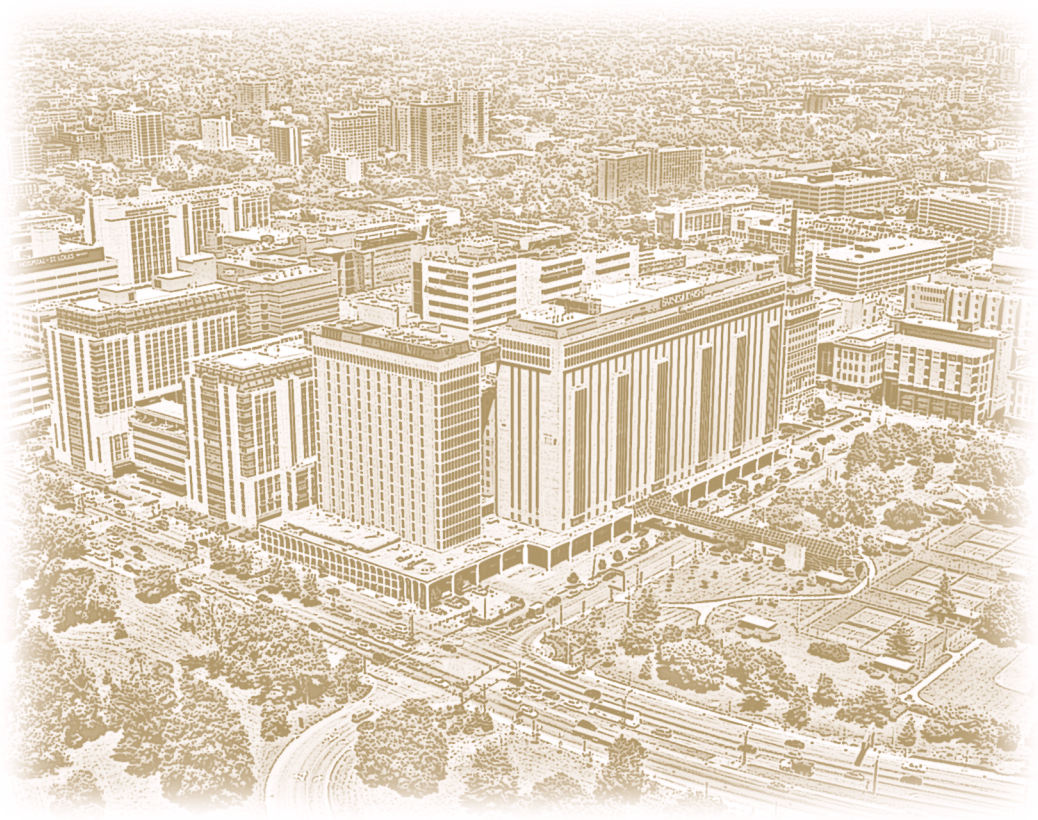

In 1927, he introduced the first course on medical ethics to students. This was reintroduced into the medical curriculum after a long hiatus in 1990 through the Humanities Program. The prize is awarded to a student who demonstrated their dedication and commitment to the importance of the Humanities in medical education throughout the course of medical school.

Hugh M. Wilson Award in Radiology

Given annually to a graduating medical student in recognition of outstanding work in radiology-related subjects, either clinical or basic science.

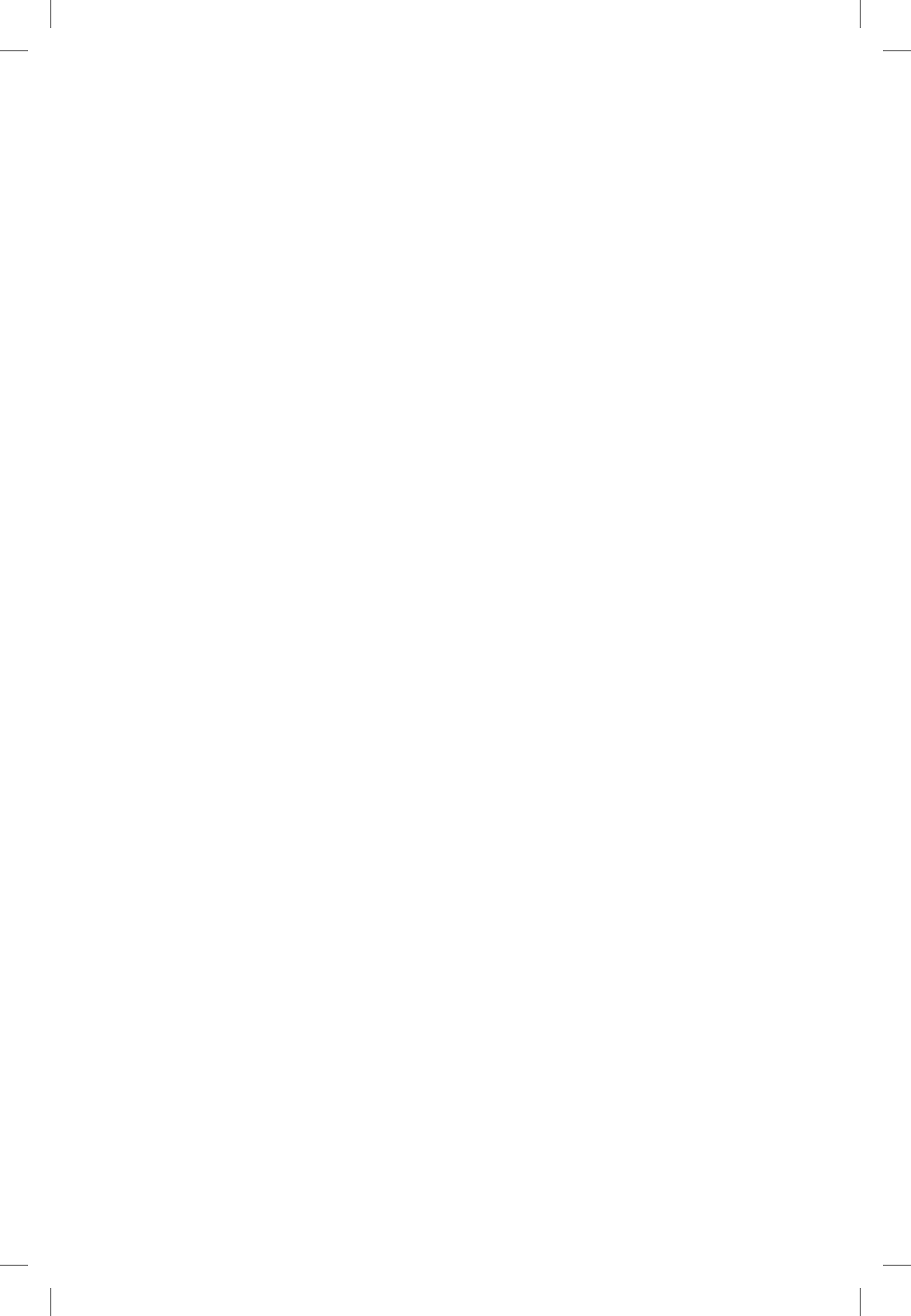

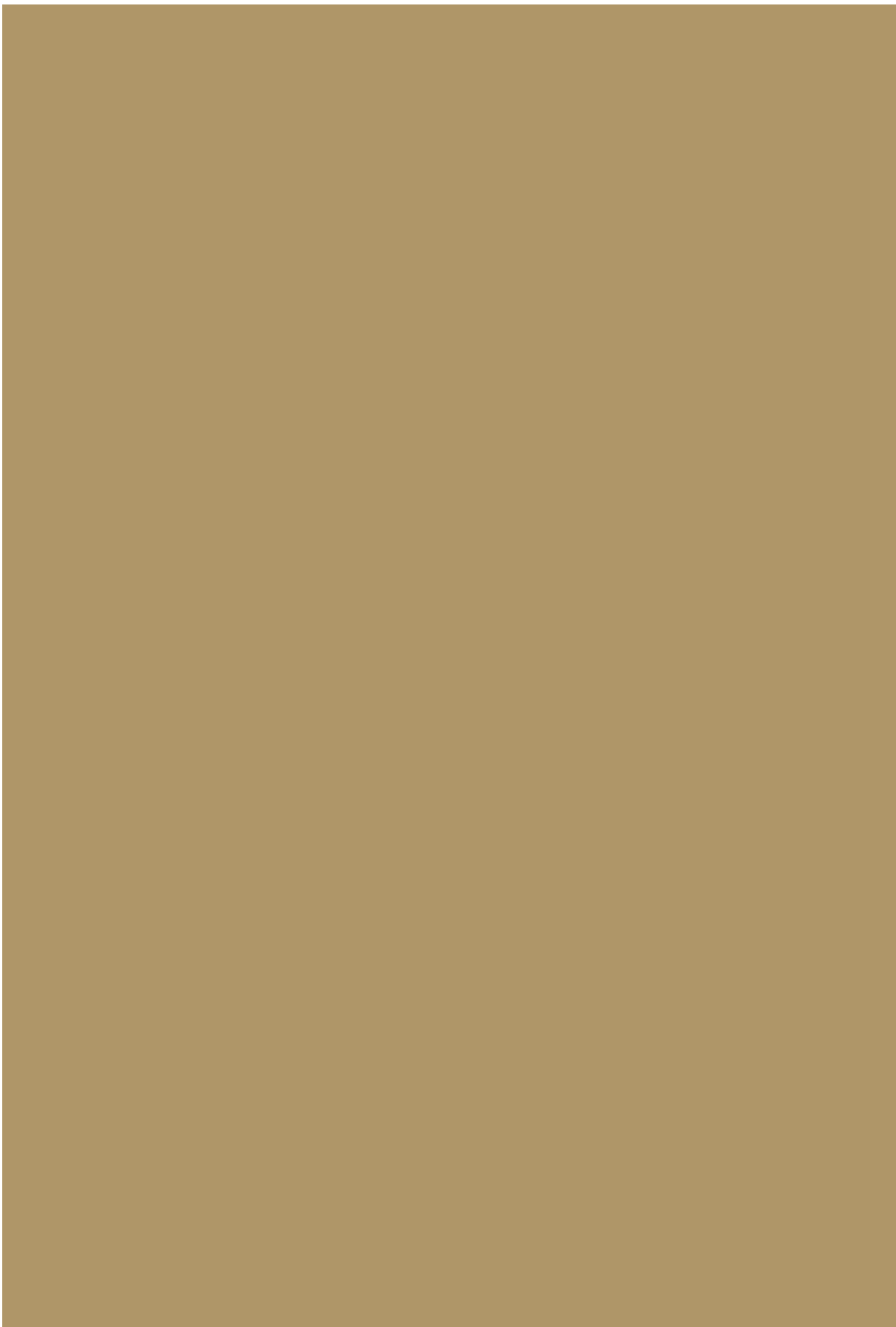

The Declaration of Geneva (Modified)

At the time of being admitted as a member of the medical profession:
I solemnly pledge myself to consecrate my life to the service of humanity;
I will give to my teachers the respect and gratitude which is their due;
I will practice my profession with conscience and dignity;
The health of my patient will be my first consideration;

I make these promises solemnly, freely, and upon my honor.
