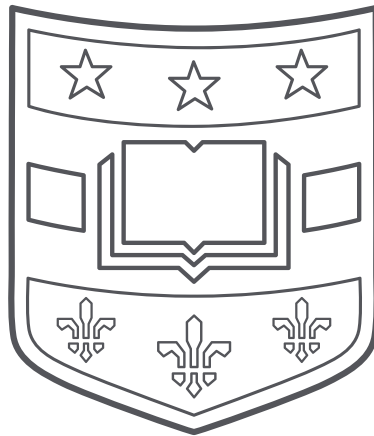

**AS A MEMBER OF THE MEDICAL PROFESSION:**

**I SOLEMNLY PLEDGE** to dedicate my life to the service of humanity;

**I WILL RESPECT** the autonomy and dignity of my patient;

**I WILL MAINTAIN** the utmost respect for human life;

**I WILL NOT PERMIT** considerations of age, disease or disability, creed, ethnic origin, gender, nationality, political affiliation, race, sexual orientation, social standing, or any other factor to intervene between my duty and my patient;

**I WILL RESPECT** the secrets that are confided in me, even after the patient has died;

**I WILL PRACTISE** my profession with conscience and dignity and in accordance with good medical practice;

**I WILL FOSTER** the honour and noble traditions of the medical profession;

**I WILL GIVE** to my teachers, colleagues, and students the respect and gratitude that is their due;

**I WILL SHARE** my medical knowledge for the benefit of the patient and the advancement of healthcare;
